**Zvonimir Jukić** (Croatia), the expert on electronic procurement, in particular publication of electronic notices as a part of electronic procurement, working in Official Gazette of the Republic of Croatia, that is in charge of the Electronic Public Procurement Portal.

Zvonimir Jukić has more than 10 years of overall experience in public procurement, working actively on setting up, developing and managing the Electronic Public Procurement Portal. He is responsible for transposition of public procurement directives into national legal system and implementation of all modules of electronic procurement.

Zvonimir Jukić is member of the working group for the development of electronic publishing and e-tendering (European Commission committee responsible for public procurement). He also works as a trainer in this area.

Dean Firkelj (Croatia), IT expert for e-Procurement

Dean Firkelj has more than 10 working years of experience in developing and implementing applications for procurement, budgeting and controlling. He was the principle architect of Croatia's Electronic Public Procurement Portal from 2011 until 2017. Since then he is working on various projects, among other – providing consulting services for SIGMA/OECD in the area of e-Procurement for various countries.

Currently he is engaged as the main architect of the new Public Procurement Portal in Serbia.

Tijana Nikolić (Serbia), attorney at law and expert on public procurement.

Tijana Nikolic has more than 8 years of overall experience in implementing and advising in public procurement for state authorities, public enterprises, organizations entrusted with public competences and companies, both from the side of contracting authority and bidders. She was involved in all phases of public procurement procedure including drafting complete tender documentation, implementation of the public procurement procedure as the president/member of the commission, as well as in proceedings before Republic Commission for the Protection of Rights in Public Procurement Procedures.
