Public Procurement Office of the Republic of Serbia with the support of the Project "Support for further improvement of Public Procurement system in Serbia" organises the Public Procurement Forum.

The idea behind organising the Public Procurement Forum is to present and discuss with the participants the most relevant issues related to the current reform of the public procurement system in Serbia.

On 23 September 2019. the Government of the Republic of Serbia adopted the Proposal for the Public Procurement Law. The new Public Procurement Law will be adopted in the forthcoming and will become effective as of 1st July 2020. The goal of the new law is complete approximation with the European Union *acquis* in the field of public procurement as well as improvement of certain legal solutions with the aim of more efficient conduct of public procurement procedures, minimizing costs and administrative burdens, greater participation of small and medium enterprises as well as efficient protection of rights in the procedure.

The new Law introduces mandatory electronic communication and exchange of information in the public procurement procedures on the Public Procurement Portal. Introducing electronic communication enables standardisation and automatization of the public procurement process for contracting authorities, but also fosters greater participation of economic operators in the public procurement procedures leading to improved market competition and greater value for invested money.

The participants of the Forum will have a chance to be acquainted with the detailed information related to the most important novelties of the Proposal of the new Public Procurement Law. Thus, the representatives of the Public Procurement Office and experts of the Project will present the most important changes which will be introduced by provisions of the new Public Procurement Law and its implementing regulations, as well as technical solutions and functionalities which will be available to contracting authorities and tenderers with the establishment of the new Public Procurement Portal. The participants will have opportunity to get acquainted with the basic functionalities of the new Public Procurement Portal through the practical work on computers.

We believe that this event for public procurement professionals and experts will be a very useful platform for exchange of information, views and opinions concerning the most relevant developments in the field of public procurement.
